

Strengths:

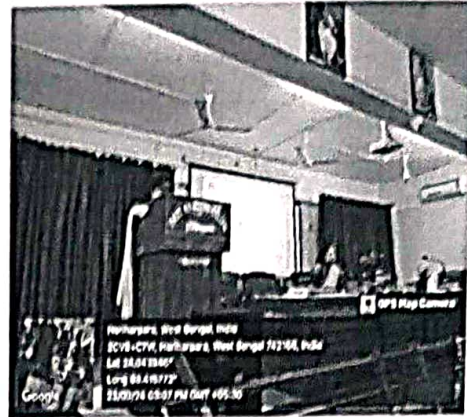
