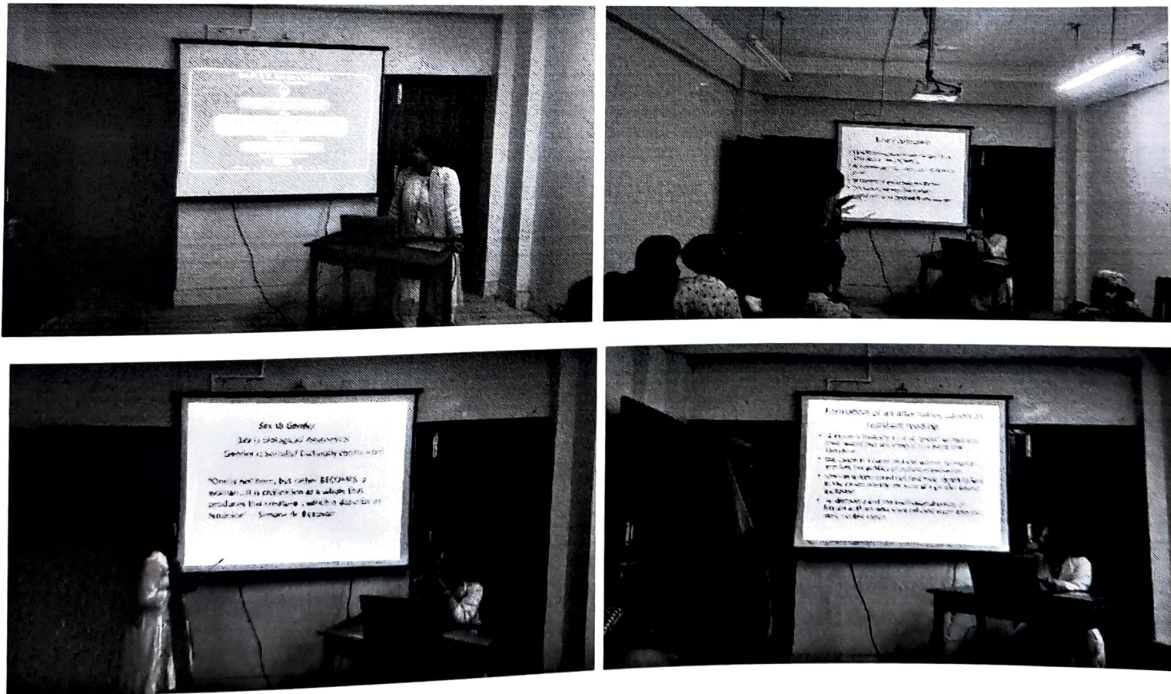
**ABOUT THE DEPARTMENT**
