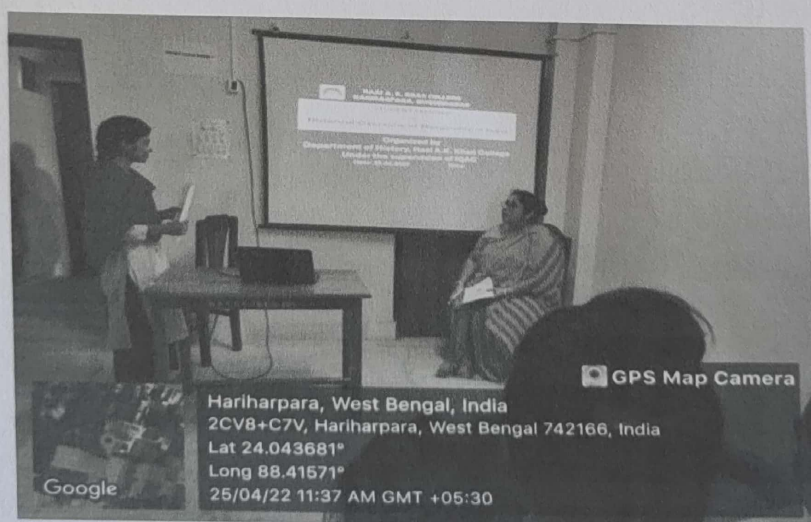
aimed to shed light on the historical context of marginality and its impact on various communities and individuals across the country.



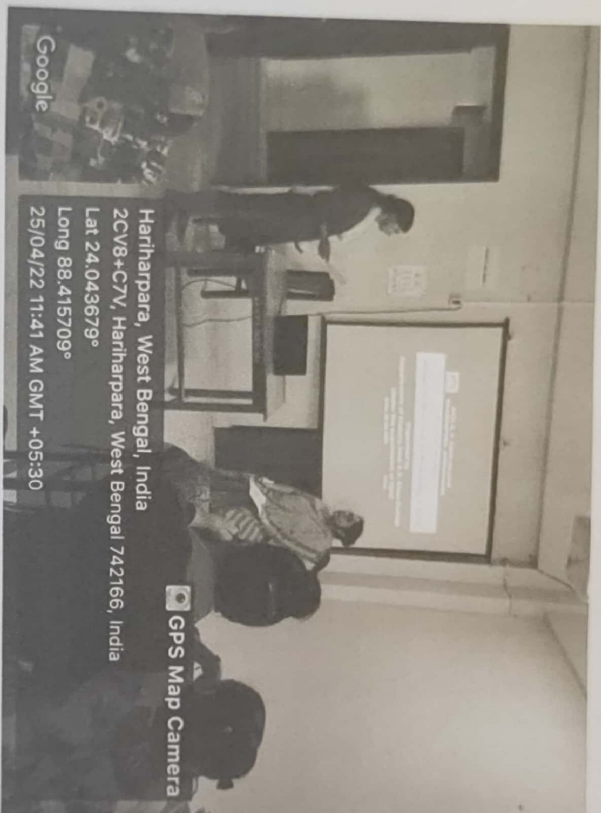
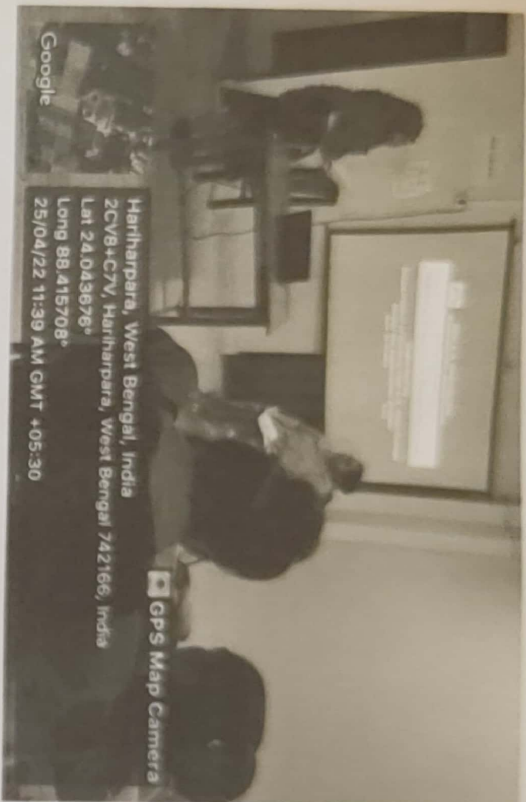
