About the Seminar

Literature is a medium of expression. It is an expression of the experiences of life: experiences of various kinds--pleasing or painful; happy or hurting; appeasing or disappointing. The writers of this genre re-live in their memories to perceive the present. The ultimate upshot is an exclamation for the crisis of space and identity.
